

## Keyboard Shortcuts: Excel 2013 (Windows)

Keyboard Shortcut	Action	Source	Comment
<b>Shift + F8</b>	<b>Add to selection (non-contiguous)</b>	Excel default	
Ctrl + Shift + 7	Adds thin border outline from selection	Excel default	
<b>Ctrl + Shift + `</b>	<b>Apply general number format</b>	Excel default	Only affects displayed format, not internal precision
<b>Ctrl + B or Ctrl + 2</b>	<b>Bold selection</b>	Excel default	
F9	Calculate now	Excel default	
Ctrl + Shift + F3	Create name using labels	Excel default	
Ctrl + T or Ctrl + L	Create table dialog box	Excel default	
<b>Ctrl + -</b>	<b>Delete cells</b>	Excel default	Memory aid: ctrl + "minus" to delete
<b>Ctrl + Shift + 5</b>	<b>Display number as percent with zero decimal places</b>	Excel default	Memory aid: shift-5 is "%"
<b>Ctrl + Shift + 6</b>	<b>Display number in scientific format with 2 decimal pts</b>	Excel default	Memory aid: shift-6 is "^"
<b>Ctrl + Shift + 1</b>	<b>Display number with 2 decimal places</b>	Excel default	
<b>Alt</b>	<b>Displays keyboard shortcuts on ribbon</b>	Excel default	Press alt again to cancel display; ESC backs up one menu
F2	<b>Edit cell; toggle edit mode while editing</b>	Excel default	
<b>Ctrl + Shift + Return</b>	<b>Enter as array formula</b>	Excel default	
<b>Shift + arrow</b>	<b>Extend selection by a cell</b>	Excel default	
<b>Ctrl + Shift + arrow</b>	<b>Extend selection to end of col/row of current region</b>	Excel default	
<b>Ctrl + I or Ctrl + 3</b>	<b>Format cells in italics</b>	Excel default	
<b>Ctrl + 1</b>	<b>Format selection dialog box</b>	Excel default	
Ctrl + End	Go to bottom right corner of sheet	Excel default	
Home	Go to col 1 of current row (or beginning of cell during edit mode)	Excel default	
Ctrl + Pg Dn	Go to next sheet	Excel default	
Alt + Pg Up	Go to one screen to left	Excel default	
Alt + Pg Dn	Go to one screen to right	Excel default	
Ctrl + Pg Up	Go to previous sheet	Excel default	
Ctrl + Home	Go to upper left corner of sheet	Excel default	
Ctrl + G (or F5)	Go to...	Excel default	
Ctrl + 0	Hide column(s)	Excel default	
Ctrl + 9	Hide row(s)	Excel default	
<b>Ctrl + Shift + =</b>	<b>Insert cells</b>	Excel default	Memory aid: ctrl + "+" to insert
Ctrl + ;	Insert current date	Excel default	
Shift + F2	Insert/edit cell comment	Excel default	
<b>Ctrl + arrow</b>	<b>Move to edge of region</b>	Excel default	
Ctrl + F3	Name Manager	Excel default	
<b>Shift + F10</b>	<b>Open contextual menu (like right-clicking the mouse)</b>	Excel default	
Ctrl + Alt + V	Paste special dialog box	Excel default	Microsoft claims this but it doesn't work on my Mac
Ctrl + Y	Redo	Excel default	
Ctrl + Shift + _	Removes all borders from selection	Excel default	
<b>Ctrl + Space</b>	<b>Select entire column</b>	Excel default	
<b>Shift + Space</b>	<b>Select entire row</b>	Excel default	
<b>Ctrl + A</b>	<b>Select the current region, or the entire worksheet</b>	Excel default	If ctrl + a selects the current region, pressing s second time selects the entire worksheet
<b>Ctrl + Shift + U</b>	<b>Toggle expand/collapse of formula bar</b>	Excel default	Allows you to see very long formulas
Ctrl + Shift + 9	Unhide row(s)	Excel default	
<b>F4</b>	<b>When editing a formula, toggle thru absolute/relative address combos</b>	Excel default

<b>Alt + 6</b>	<b>Decrease decimal places</b>	<b>Personal (keyboard shortcut tool)</b>	Shortcut depends on position in Quick Access toolbar
<b>Alt + 7</b>	<b>Increase decimal places</b>	<b>Personal (keyboard shortcut tool)</b>	Shortcut depends on position in Quick Access toolbar
<b>Alt + 0 + 9</b>	<b>Merge Cells</b>	<b>Personal (keyboard shortcut tool)</b>	Shortcut depends on position in Quick Access toolbar
<b>Alt + 5</b>	<b>Align middle</b>	<b>Personal (keyboard shortcut tool)</b>	Shortcut depends on position in Quick Access toolbar
<b>Alt + 3</b>	<b>Align center</b>	<b>Personal (Quick Access Toolbar)</b>	Shortcut depends on position in Quick Access toolbar
<b>Alt + 2</b>	<b>Align left</b>	<b>Personal (Quick Access Toolbar)</b>	Shortcut depends on position in Quick Access toolbar
<b>Alt + 4</b>	<b>Align right</b>	<b>Personal (Quick Access Toolbar)</b>	Shortcut depends on position in Quick Access toolbar
<b>Alt + 1</b>	<b>Column autofit selection</b>	<b>Personal (Quick Access Toolbar)</b>	Shortcut depends on position in Quick Access toolbar
<b>Esc</b>	<b>Cancel edit or change</b>	<b>Windows system default</b>	
<b>Ctrl + F4 or Ctrl + W</b>	<b>Close window</b>	<b>Windows system default</b>	
<b>Ctrl + C</b>	<b>Copy</b>	<b>Windows system default</b>	
<b>Ctrl + X</b>	<b>Cut</b>	<b>Windows system default</b>	
<b>Ctrl + Tab</b>	<b>Next window</b>	<b>Windows system default</b>	
<b>Ctrl + V</b>	<b>Paste</b>	<b>Windows system default</b>	
<b>Ctrl + Z</b>	<b>Undo</b>	<b>Windows system default</b>
