## **Lecture Questions: Ozone Depletion**

These questions are taken from chapter 2 of your textbook (sections 1 and 6–12) and from the paper entitled "Twenty Questions and Answers About the Ozone Layer: 2010 Update."

- 1. At what altitudes is the ozone layer located? What is the maximum concentration of ozone in the ozone layer?
- 2. The *Chapman cycle* explains how the ozone layer is formed and maintained. Please describe this process in some detail.
- 3. What are CFCs? What are they used for?
- 4. How do CFCs destroy ozone? Explain in some detail.
- 5. These questions are about the 'ozone hole.'
  - (a) What is it? Be sure to explain where and when it forms.
  - (b) When was the ozone hole first detected? By whom?
  - (c) How does the ozone hole form? Why doesn't it form elsewhere?
- 6. What treaty was signed to control ozone depletion, and when did it go into effect? How effective has it been in controlling stratospheric chlorine levels?
- 7. How severe has stratospheric ozone depletion been on a global scale? When is it expected to recover?
